David S. Taylor

David S. Taylor, 70, of Locust Valley died on April 2, 1995. He was a member of H.G. Wellington & Co., Inc. a stock brokerage firm based in New York City and Chairman of the Board of Trustees of North Shore University Hospital at Manhasset, and the North Shore Health System.

A native of New York City, Mr. Taylor graduated from the Taft School and received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Yale University. He served in the Navy and Air Force as a flight instructor during WWII and remained in the Naval Reserve until 1954. He was an executive of Canada Dry Corp. from 1949 until 1954 when he joined Wellington, where he also served as Executive Vice President and Director.

His community activities included membership on the Boards of Greenvale School, the Taft School, Piping Rock Club, and the Planning Board of Old Brookville. He was a member of the Nassau County Militia and Partisan Civic Association from 1950 to 1970 and received the Theodore Roosevelt Award for Community Service in 1990.

Mr. Taylor joined the Board of Trustees of Community Hospital of Glen Cove in 1964 and served as Chairman of its Board from 1988 until 1990 when it became North Shore University Hospital at Glen Cove. He continued his service on the parent Board of North Shore in the role of Vice Chairman prior to his assuming Chairmanship in June of 1994.
